As announced in the ISLSSL Bulletin no. 145, next June, from Sunday 18 to Saturday 24, 2017, will take place in Venice, Università Cà Foscari, the 4<sup>th</sup> International Seminar on International and Comparative Labour Law.

The 2017 edition of the Seminar will be dedicated to the issue of *Global Trade and Social Rights*.

All Seminar's participants are invited to take an active part in the discussion, from an interdisciplinary perspective.

Of course, the interested scholars will be able to choose some different perspectives of analysis linked to the general theme of the Seminar.

## SESSION/DEADLINES/DIMENSION

This call for paper/participation is aimed to all the Labour Law Scholars who meet the requirements provided by their respective National Association to be considered as Young Scholars.

They could submit their abstract (no more than 1.800 characters, including spaces, with concise title), within the deadline of May 31, 2017: the abstracts will have to be sent to the both addresses <a href="mailto:stefanobellomo@mmba.it">stefanobellomo@mmba.it</a> and <a href="mailto:islsslseminar@gmail.com">islsslseminar@gmail.com</a>. The abstract will be examined by the Venice Seminar Organizer in a few days after receipt. If the abstracts will be accepted, the full papers (no more than 30.000 characters, including spaces, footnotes and appendix) will have to be presented in the session of 23rd June 2017.
