Theoretical articles - Doctrine (subjects freely chosen by the authors)

Editorial line of the Studies section

The Studies section of the *Revue de Droit comparé du Travail et de la Sécurité Sociale 2027/1* will publish academic doctrinal articles in social law on topics freely chosen by the authors.

The *Revue* favours contributions in the field of comparative law, including those dealing with the national implementation of international or regional law.

Articles dealing exclusively with one national legal system are also welcome, provided they involve substantial contextualisation efforts to facilitate their understanding by an international readership and their use from a comparative law perspective.

The *Revue* publishes original articles; however, it may accept previously published articles (in English or Spanish), provided they are substantially reworked to align with the editorial line.

Format of contributions

Contributions must be in French, English, or Spanish and must not exceed **40,000 characters**, including footnotes and spaces.

Articles submitted in English or Spanish will be translated and then published in French. When a translation into French is produced, it is carried out under the responsibility of the Editors-in-Chief and the members of the Editorial Board and is subject to the author's approval.

Manuscripts must be accompanied by the following information:

- Title of the article
- An abstract of approximately 400 characters in French and in English, as well as keywords in each language (approx. 5) to identify the content of the article
- Name of the author's institution or organisation
- The author's research fields and bibliographic references (two publications of their choice)
- The author's postal and e-mail addresses

Schedule

- Deadline for submission of completed manuscripts: **15 September 2026**
- Manuscript to be sent to revue.comptrasec@u-bordeaux.fr with copies (cc) to mathilde.nicoli@u-bordeaux.fr
- Answer to authors: **Early October 2026**
- Deadline for submission of final versions of articles (incorporating minor or major recommendations): **15 December 2025**

Assessment procedure

Texts submitted to the *Revue* are subject to an anonymous peer review process from independent experts. In the first step, article proposals are evaluated by the Editorial Board, which assesses the admissibility of the manuscript. If accepted, the manuscript is submitted to two external reviewers for assessment. When the reviewers provide feedback, the author can make minor or major changes. **All requests for major modifications require a second round of peer review.**

On the basis of the assessment, the Editorial Board of the *Revue* decides whether or not to publish the submitted manuscripts.

Dissemination procedure

The print version of issue 2027/1 of the *Revue de droit comparé du travail et de la sécurité sociale* will be published in March 2027. The articles will also be available online on [OpenEdition](https://journals.openedition.org/rdctss/).

Authors will receive a print copy of the issue of the *Revue* to which they have contributed. The editorial team will also provide them with an electronic offprint.
