**Deadline for paper proposals: 1 July 2023**

#### Studies

Theoretical articles - Doctrine (Subjects freely chosen by the authors)

The Studies section of the *Revue de Droit comparé du Travail et de la Sécurité Sociale* 2024/1 will publish theoretical articles - Doctrine - on subjects freely chosen by the authors.

#### Format of contributions

Contributions must be in French, English or Spanish and must not exceed **40,000 characters**, including footnotes and spaces.

Manuscripts must be accompanied by the following information:

- The title of the article.
- An abstract of approximately 400 characters in French and English, as well as key words in each language (approx. 5) to identify the content of the article.
- The name of the author's institution or organization.
- The author's research fields and bibliographic references (choice of two publications).
- The author's postal and e-mail addresses.

#### Timetable

- Deadline for submitting article proposals (title + 400-word abstract + proposed outline):  
**1 July 2023**

#### Evaluation procedure

Texts submitted to the Journal undergo a double blind evaluation by independent experts. Firstly, proposed articles are evaluated by the Editorial Board, which assesses the admissibility of the manuscript. If accepted, the manuscript is submitted to two external reviewers for assessment. When the reviewers return, recommendations for minor or major changes may be made to the author. **All requests for major modifications require a second round of peer review.**

On the basis of the assessments, the Journal's Editorial Board decides whether or not to publish the manuscripts submitted.
