Full justification, single-spaced.

Article Structure: In accordance with the following formatting guidelines:

First level: 1. PENSIONS Second level: 1.1 PENSIONS Third level: 1.1.1 Pensions Fourth level: A) Pensions

At the end, include a list of cited bibliography. Other Formal Aspects: Within the text of the originals, words or phrases should not be bolded or underlined. Italics are acceptable, but should

be used sparingly. Citations. Legislative or judicial references should, whenever possible, include the references from the database being used (or, failing that, they should be cited with information that ensures their identification and effective location, such as the Official Gazette where they were published, the appeal or judgment number, etc.). The surnames of cited authors should be capitalized, with only the first letter capitalized, and in small caps. First names should be initialed only. Examples: -If it is a work by a single author or co-authored by up to four authors: RODRÍGUEZ INIESTA, G.: *Las prestaciones por muerte y supervivencia.
