YOUNG SCHOLARS' POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Collateral Event of the 18th International Conference in Commemoration of prof Marco Biagi

Modena, Italy, 19-20 March 2020 Marco Biagi Foundation, University of Modena and Reggio Emilia

The Marco Biagi Foundation invites PhD candidates and post-doctoral researchers (holding a post-doctoral grant) to submit abstracts for a Poster Presentation Session that will take place in the framework of the 18th International Conference in Commemoration of Professor Marco Biagi. The Conference will take place in Modena, Italy, 19-20 March 2020.

The Conference's Scientific Committee will select up to ten abstracts to be presented in poster format in the Session.

The deadline for submitting proposals is **15 January 2020**. Authors of selected proposals will be notified by **31 January 2020**.

Abstracts should address and illustrate research projects that fall within the field of Labour and Employment Relations from one of the following disciplinary perspectives: law, industrial relations, labour economics, organization theory, human resources management. Special consideration will be paid to those topics and original research projects, concluded or in progress, that allow for an interdisciplinary dialogue involving two or more of these disciplines, and that show a specific concern for international and/or comparative issues. **The proposals do not need to match the theme of the main conference**.

Scholars willing to participate in the workshop should submit a 500 word abstract along with a resume, including the proponent's educational and academic career, publications, and contact information, no later than 15 January 2020. Please submit the abstract electronically (in English). The preferred format for submission is Microsoft Word.

Abstracts should include the poster title and a bibliography, and should make specific reference to disciplinary field, academic affiliation of the author, research question(s), methodology and main findings or outcomes achieved or expected.

Posters co-authored by established academics will not be considered.

The selected posters will be displayed at the conference venue for the whole duration of the conference. Specific time slots will be reserved for the Authors to meet with the attendants and illustrate and discuss their projects.

The working language of the workshop will be **English**.

Authors of selected abstracts should submit the poster at the Conference opening on 19 March.





The poster printing is demanded to the presenter, according to A1 (594mm x 841mm) or A0 (841mm x 1189mm) portrait format.

Presenters of posters will be entitled to:

- free admission to the International Conference and social events;
- light lunches by the Conference venue on 19 March and 20 March.
